CONDITIONS OF ENTRY TO THE WEERAMA PROCESSION

1. The Weerama Festival/Procession Committee reserves the right to determine the number of entries in the Procession.
2. The Weerama Festival/Procession Committee reserves the right to accept or reject entries into the Procession. Decisions regarding acceptance of entries is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
3. It is the responsibility of the Procession entrants to effect any insurance cover for the duration of Weerama in respect of entries, vehicles and individuals.
4. Procession entries **must** meet the requirements of the Weerama Festival Committee overseeing the Procession.
5. All vehicles must be decorated and include a colourful side curtain. All marching / walking participants are required to wear colourful costumes. Floats not up to standard will be excluded from the Procession.
6. The Weerama Festival/Lions' Procession Committee will not accept any responsibility for damages to floats or loss or damage to personal property or injury to personnel or animals.
7. Procession participants agree to obey the direction of Marshals at all times.
8. All vehicles participating in the Procession must have current registration and licensed drivers.
9. No 'give-aways' are to be thrown from floats. Please provide a streetwalker to give out any promotional material. These must not slow the float down.
10. Please Note:— EVERYONE IS REQUIRED TO **KEEP MOVING IN A FORWARD DIRECTION AND KEEP REASONABLY CLOSE TO THE FLOAT IN FRONT. GROUP ENTRIES MUST NOT EXTEND WHILE MARCHING.**
